



Sales instructions

Hand in clothing and toys:

FRIDAY between 16.00 – 17.00 en 19.30 – 20.30

Pick up (clothing and toys left overs) and pay out of your earnings:

SATURDAY between 16.00-16.30

Please note: a maximum of **40 items** of clothing per number. A maximum of **3 stuffed animals** and **10 books** (a bundle of magazines counts as 1 book) per sales number.

→ Want to sell more? You can request one extra number 10 days before the fair.

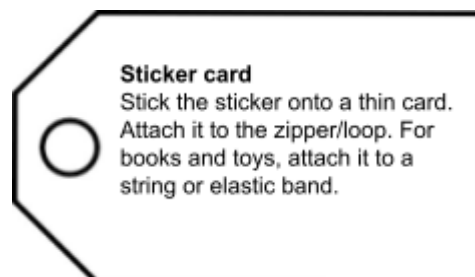
Please note: Please deliver toys and clothing separately, each in a separate bag/crate.

Please note: If you are unable to attend, please cancel using the cancellation form:

<https://forms.gle/z2jEciyVkbvV9Mcm7> If you do not do this, you will not receive an early-bird email for the next fair. If you have not canceled your registration for two fairs, you will no longer receive a sales number.

Here's how to apply stickers correctly:

- **Our sticker sheets are mandatory** (€0.50 per sheet of 24 stickers). The points of sale are listed in the email.
- Scratching out, overwriting old prices or sales numbers is not permitted (to prevent fraud and discussions).
- Prices: rounded to **whole or half euros** (e.g., 0.50, 1.50, 3.00, etc.).
- Clearly write down your **sales number**, which can be found in the seller's email.
- Provide a clear description of the item: color/type/brand. This helps the buyer and us to find the item if the sticker comes off. Example of a good description: "Dark blue T-shirt with orange trim, brand..." or "Jip & Janneke wooden puzzle, 100 pieces."
- Location of the sticker: on the **left shoulder/left upper side** of the garment.
- Article in two or more parts: fasten with a safety pin/thread.
- The sticker often does not stick well to jackets and other garments made of synthetic fabric. That is why a sticker card (see image) sells better.
- Also for **toys/books**: a string/elastic band with a sticker card attached. **Do not stick it on the item** to prevent damage.

Please note: since last spring fair, you will no longer receive a receipt for the items sold, so if you want to keep track of this, take a photo in advance (and follow our social media channels for useful tips on how to keep track of this).

Sales directions:

- Childrens clothing **size 92 tot 176**, teenagers **size xs and s** and childrens toys, appropriate for the season: summer **or** winter.
- Clothing and toys should be of **good quality: clean, intact/complete, and smell fresh**. Ironed clothing sells better.
- Please deliver your toys and clothing separately, each in a sturdy plastic bag or crate with the sales number clearly displayed. Contents will be checked by staff. Rejected items will be returned to you on Saturday afternoon.
- Toys with loose parts: please pack them in a transparent bag or cling film. Is everything complete?
- Always make sure your clothing is **appropriate for the season!** So thick (fleece) jackets and thick sweaters only in winter, sandals and shorts only in spring ;)

What is allowed?

- Clothing appropriate for the season
- Costumes
- Onesies and bathrobes
- Sportswear
- Sports shoes (indoor and outdoor), hiking boots, rollerblades, (roller) skates, ballet and gym shoes,
- Boots, snow boots, water shoes, crocs, and teva sandals (appropriate for the season!).
- Socks/tights: labeled with size, bundled/returned in a transparent bag.
- **Maximum of 3 stuffed animals and 10 books** (bundle of magazines = 1 book) per sales number.

What is NOT allowed?

- No clothing with holes, frayed edges, stains, discoloration, or other defects.
- No “regular” shoes or slippers.
- No underwear, bodysuits, or pajamas.
- No videotapes or DVDs.

Recommended retail prices (size 92 t/m 176 and teenage size xs and s):

pants	€ 2,50 - 10,00	rain boots and sport shoes	€ 2,00 - 10,00
sweaters, hoodies, jumpers	€ 2,50 - 10,00	sportswear and gym clothing	€ 2,00 - 10,00
coats and jackets	€ 5,00 - 20,00	swimwear	€ 2,00 - 5,00
ski suits (only in winter)	€ 5,00 - 15,00	t-shirts(short sleeves only in summer)	€ 2,00 - 8,00
dresses	€ 2,50 - 10,00	short pants (only in summer))	€ 2,00 - 5,00
socks (in a bundle)	€ 1,00 - 2,00	skirts	€ 2,00 - 5,00
